



Travel to Warsaw

Warsaw is located in the east-center Poland and can be easily reached by airplane, car or train.

Arriving by airplane:

Most of planes to Warsaw land at <u>Chopin Airport</u> which we recommend as it is located closer to the conference venue.

To reach the Regent Hotel we recommend taking bus or taxi.

The most convenient way to reach Łukasiewicz – Institute of Aviation is to take a taxi.

There is a taxi rank in front of the terminal exit where <u>Ele Taxi</u> corporation stops.

Arriving by train:

Warsaw has three large railway stations serving international and long-distance domestic traffic:

<u>Warsaw Central Railway Station</u> is located in the very center of the city and has very good transport connections with all Warsaw districts.

Warsaw East Railway Station which is located on the right bank of the Vistula river.

Arriving by car:

A2 Highway, exit Opacz-Kolonia on S7 Expressway

Route E77 approaching from the north

Route E67 or E77 approaching from the south

Route E30 approaching from the west

Arriving at the Regent Hotel/Łukasiewicz - Institute of Aviation:

The Regent Hotel is located near the Łazienki Królewskie Park and can be easily reached form the airport or railway stations. Łukasiewicz – Institute of Aviation is located in the southern part of the city, near the airport. You can reach the venues by:

Airplane:

Bus/Tram:

Regent Hotel

The closest bus stop is Goworka 51 at which several buses stop

Łukasiewicz – Institute of Aviation

 The closest bus/tram stop from the conference venue is Instytut Lotnictwa 02 at which several trams and buses stop

parking spots available at <u>P+R Parking</u> on Krakowska av. where are also 4 charging stations for electric cars. To arrive from the P+R Parking we recommend to take the <u>tram.</u>
